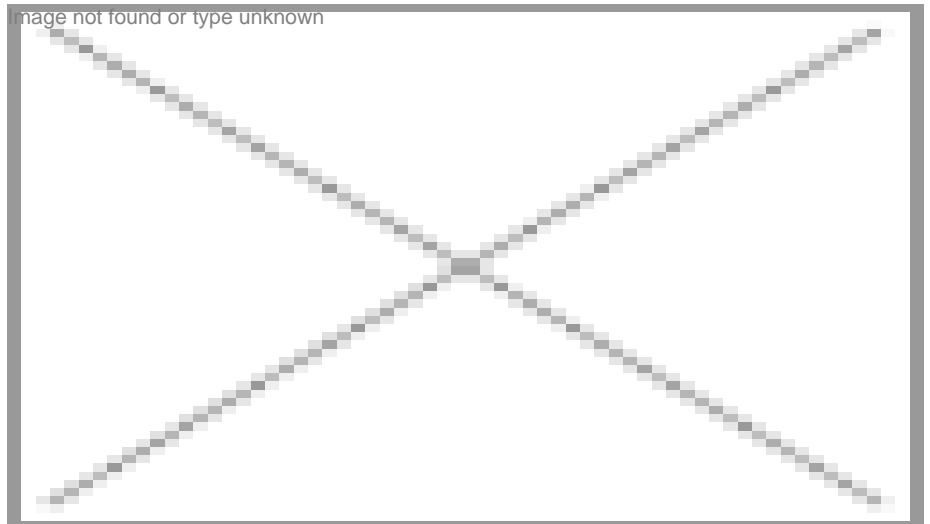

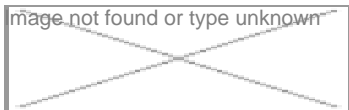

In these times of COVID-19, never has John Wooden's one-liner 'flexibility is the key to stability' been more valid.

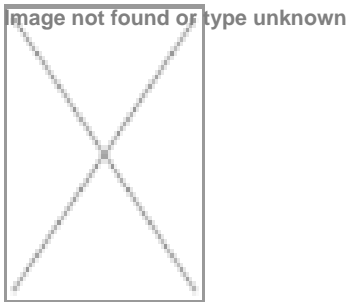

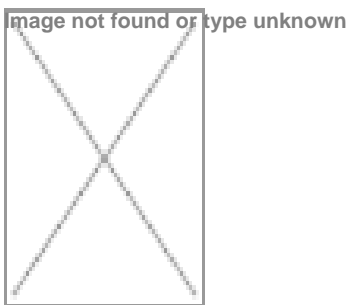
